

CAMPBELL COUNTY CATTLEWOMEN SCHOLARSHIP

Two \$500 scholarships will be given annually to be used for educational purposes and in particular for the benefit of undergraduate students attending a college, university, industrial or trade school. No consideration will be given to economic or financial need of applicant. After meeting the eligibility criteria, recipients will be selected on the basis of agriculture background, 4-H & FFA involvement, agriculture classes, academic and civic achievement, and future in agriculture and beef production or promotion.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Minimum 3.0 GPA
2. Must be a Campbell County resident
3. Mother, grandmother, or applicant must be a Cattlewomen member
4. Submit one page essay on how your education will be used in agriculture and promoting beef.

Pointing system for awarding scholarship (1 point for each criteria)

1. Going into ag-related field
2. 4-H involvement
3. FFA involvement
4. Beef projects in 4-H or FFA
5. Ag classes in high school
6. Ag related vocational classes (accounting, business, computer could count as they can help with an ag-business)
7. Ag related volunteer activities
8. Wyoming Stock Growers membership (self or parents)
9. Civic involvement
10. Academic achievement (GPA, ACT score, challenge of classes taken)
11. Ranch family background
12. Beef Ambassador involvement
