St. Patrick wasn't Irish, and he wasn't born in Ireland. Patrick's
parents were Roman citizens living in modern-day England, or
more precisely in Scotland or Wales (scholars cannot agree on
which).

The original color associated with St. Patrick is blue, not green as
commonly believed. In several artworks depicting the saint, he is
shown wearing blue vestments. King Henry VIII used the Irish harp
in gold on a blue flag to represent the country. Since that time, and
possibly before, blue has been a popular color to represent the
country on flags, coats-of-arms, and even sports jerseys.
