All students will have the opportunity to confirm a schedule based on courses you requested previously. As you finalize your schedule, be sure that your selected courses support your college and career interests.

The scheduling dates will be announced as soon as possible.

Each scheduling window will open at 6 PM, at which time you can:

Review your schedule.

1. Do you have classes for math, English, science, social studies?
2. Have you met your PE and Health requirements?
3. Have you met the prerequisites for each course?
4. Have you failed a course you need to repeat?
5. Do you have the same teacher both semesters for year-long classes?

If you want to change a class, you may try to do so.

1. Your choices will be limited to the alternates you selected in March.
2. Your choices will be limited by class size and availability.

Once the window is open, students can complete the scheduling process at home using any internet friendly device (i.e. laptops, personal computers, smart phones, tablets). The website that you will sign into is:

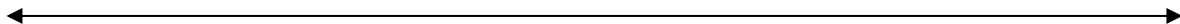
